

BEDROOMS

COUGH OR SNEEZE

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze.

Don't shake hands and hug when saying hello. Wash your hands very often with soap and water.

HAND-SANITIZER

Hand-sanitizer is available in all common areas of the hotel.

MASK

Wearing a mask is MANDATORY throughout the hotel.

If you show any sign of sickness during your stay, please contact immediately the front desk from your room (9), then stay isolated while waiting for medical instructions.

AIR CONDITIONING

To adjust the temperature of your room, a remote control is located on your nightstand.

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

The rooms are available to you from 2 p.m. They must be vacated by 11:00 am on the day of your departure. The night before, you will receive a departure letter with various information, as well as the invoice for your stay in order to verify its accuracy. For an early departure, you can anticipate the payment of your bill. For a late check-out, reception will inform you about availability and prices. Call 9 for any request.

BANKS

Banks are located in Maharepa and are open Monday through Friday, and for one of them, Saturday until 11:45 am. You can also change money at the reception.

CONCIERGE

Our concierge service is available to assist you during your stay with numerous services including:

ANIMALS

MOSQUITOES

There are 3,534 species of mosquitoes. They have an extremely important role in ecosystems. It is recommended to use mosquito repellent to avoid bites, although our property is regularly treated against these insects with biodegradable products. An anti-mosquito plug is available in each of the bungalows.

LIZARDS / GECKOS / MARGOUILLATS

In Polynesia, these animals are considered sacred and bring good luck. They are harmless, live in clean places and are very appreciated because they eat harmful insects (mosquitoes...). They have a very good hearing, a good eyesight and can emit sounds (clacking or short loud calls).

COCKS

Cocks are a part of the daily life in French Polynesia. They are wild and belong to nobody! The urban legend tells that they are still under the jet-lag and that is why you can hear them sing from morning till night!

B

SWIMMING

To help us preserve the beauty of the lagoon, please avoid contact with the corals. We recommend that you wear water shoes to protect yourself from cuts from coral or sea urchins.

C

CORALS

The lagoon is protected and we are engaged in the restoration of the coral, so you can discover areas of rehabilitation. We offer you a coral cuttings activity. Dial 1245 for more information.

ELECTRIC POWER

In Polynesia, the electricity current is 220 volts. For any device that needs a transformer or an adapter, contact reception.

FIRE / SECURITY

The hotel is equipped with a fire detection system in each room. All the different areas of the hotel are equipped with audible alarms, fire extinguishers and firehoses.

If a fire starts in your room, trigger the nearest alarm or call reception (9).

- STAY CALM
- Behind your bedroom door is posted an evacuation plan
- Check where the fire extinguisher is at the entrance to your room
- Identify on the map, your location and, if necessary, the meeting place indicated by green signs
- Always keep your room key on the nightstand

IF YOU DETECT A FIRE?

- STAY CALM
- Call Reception (9) and indicate your position and the precise location where the fire started.
- If it is a small fire, there are fire extinguishers at each room entrance
- Activate the nearest fire alarm

WHAT TO DO IF YOU HEAR AN AUDIBLE ALARM?

- STAY CALM
- Take your key, look at the evacuation plan
- And go to the nearest evacuation point.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE TO EVACUATE?

- STAY CALM
- Take your key
- Take your valuables and identity document and join the assembly areas
- Identify the nearest evacuation point on the map behind your door

If you need special assistance or if you are inconvenienced in your movements, notify the reception staff (9) upon arrival or during your stay.

PHONE & COMMUNICATION

Your phone is located on your nightstand. To make a national call, dial 0 and wait for the dial tone, then dial the number of your correspondent (in Polynesia only 8 digits: 40 for landline + 6 digits and 87 or 89 for cell phone then 6 digits.
